English

In English we will be making links with our topics to provide opportunities to write a variety of genres including: diaries, narratives and information texts. We will also be writing descriptions of characters and settings. Some of our work will be based around the popular novels "The London Eye Mystery" and "The Creakers". Where possible we will be linking the writing to our topic work. Handwriting and spelling is also a big focus in year 4 and children will be practising joining letters. We will also be working with the children on their grammar and punctuation and placing an increased emphasis on reading comprehension, particularly during regular guided reading sessions as well as shared

reading sessions.


Children in Year 4 will be learning a variety of skills in PE lessons such as throwing, catching, balancing and dance.

Maths

In Maths we will be focusing on place value and calculation methods. Children will be working with increasingly larger numbers. We will build on our knowledge of written methods from previous years for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Children will also be working on their arithmetic, reasoning and problem solving skills.



During year 4 children will be learning their multiplication tables on a daily basis. Please encourage your child to read the times table they are learning every day to enable them to progress quicker. To help them with this we have access to various websites. The children have their login details for Times Tables Rockstars, and Sumdog.

Science

Science lessons are often embedded in our topic work and this term we will be looking at studying electricity and states of matter. Children will have the opportunity to make predictions, observations and evaluations, as well as complete simple experiments This is known as working scientifically.
