Phonics and Reading



We follow the Little Wandle Phonics programme and we have started teaching daily phonics sessions with the children. We have also started to do reading sessions 3 times per week. Following these sessions, the children will take home the book they have been reading in class to continue practising at home to help build their confidence and fluency when reading independently.

Please can we ensure that each time you read with your child, you comment and sign in their reading diaries. We would like to see a minimum of **3** different times you have signed each week. It is important that the books are returned every day, even if your child's books are not scheduled to be changed. If any books are lost or damaged, there is a £5 charge.

Please feel free to come and talk to us about your child's reading at any time. You can really help by building their comprehension skills by asking questions about the book.

Wellies and Mac's
