Explorers Topic

Our first school topic this term will



be 'Explorers'. During this topic, we will be learning all about different biomes around the world and their features. We will also be learning about living things and how they adapt to survive in these biomes. We will be looking at how to read maps, locate places using grid references and preparing our own maps. We will also be taking inspiration from Inuit art to create our own pieces of artwork.

In Autumn 2, our topic will be 'Evolution and Inheritance where we look at living things and how they have changed over time; fossils, and 'survival of the fittest'.

Class Novel - Wonder

As an introduction to year 6, all of our learning will be based around the book

Wonder. We will be working on our reading skills as well as using this as a basis for our RHSE lessons to discuss our feelings, worries and hopes for the year ahead.

English

To begin with, we will be reminding ourselves of our basic grammar skills, using these to write a description using exciting vocabulary.

We will work on our descriptive writing skills by extending our vocabulary and using a variety of word types. We will also be writing a diary retelling the events of the expedition.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths, we will be focusing on developing our knowledge of place value, becoming familiar with numbers from tens of millions down to decimals. We will also be looking at our reasoning and problem solving skills and using different methods to break these down.

As arithmetic is a big part of the end of year SATs, each week we will be practising our arithmetic skills, to build our confidence in this area.
